LANGUAGE IMMERSION PROGRAM REQUIREMENTS FOR HIGH SCHOOL RECOGNITION





1. Certificate of Participation

- a. Student needs to have passed a minimum of 2 years high school Spanish (TWIS 3, Spanish IV, AP Spanish IV Language & Culture, AP Spanish V Literature & Culture)
- b. Student needs to have passed either the TWI World History Honors <u>OR</u> Saddleback College Spanish class

2. Certificate of Participation and Cord

- a. Student needs to have passed a minimum of 3 years high school Spanish (TWIS 3, Spanish IV, AP Spanish IV Language & Culture, AP Spanish V Literature & Culture) with a minimum GPA of 3.0
- b. Student needs to have passed either the TWI World History Honors <u>OR</u> Saddleback College Spanish class with a minimum academic GPA of 3.0

3. Certificate of Participation and Distinguished Cord

- a. Student needs to have passed a minimum of 3 years high school Spanish (TWIS 3, AP Spanish IV Language & Culture, AP Spanish V Literature & Culture) with a minimum GPA of 3.0
- b. Student needs to have passed <u>BOTH</u> the TWI World History Honors <u>AND</u> the Saddleback College Spanish class with a minimum academic GPA of 3.0
- c. Student needs to have maintained a minimum overall academic GPA of 3.0

All TWI students are eligible for the Seal of Biliteracy by completing the following requirements:

- 1. Completion of all English Language Arts requirements for graduation with an overall grade point average of 2.0 or above in those classes.
- 2. Students must have scores from one of the following tests administered in grade eleven:
 - Smarter Balanced Assessment (SBA) Standard Met or Standard Exceeded
 - \circ SAT 500 or above on the critical reading section
 - ACT 22 or above on English Test
 - Advanced Placement (AP) 3 or above on the Language & Composition or Literature & Comp. test
- 3. Demonstrate proficiency in one or more languages, in addition to English, through one of the following criteria:
 - Pass a world language Advanced Placement examination with a score of 3 or higher.
 - Successfully complete a four-year high school course of study in a specific world language and attain an overall grade point average of 3.0 or above in that course of study.
 - Pass the world language SAT Test II examination with a score of 600 or higher.
- **4.** If the primary language of a student is other than English, the student shall meet both of the following criteria:
 - Attain the early advance proficiency level required California English Language Development Test (CELDT).
 - o Meet all the criteria listed above in 1, 2, and 3. Minimum overall academic GPA of 2.0
