Earning Your Diploma

To Earn Your Diploma You Must:

- **Complete a minimum of 220 credits** (Seniors should have at least 160 credits)
- **Pass 12th grade English course** (ex: AP Lit, ERWC)
- **Pass 12th grade Social Science course** (ex: AP Econ, Gov/Econ, AP Gov)
- **Complete any graduation requirements that *have not yet* been fulfilled** (ex: electives)

If a student doesn't complete the above requirements , they will not receive their diploma in June and will not participate in the graduation commencement ceremony.

- UC does not require letters of recommendation
- UC requires completion of four Personal Insight Questions.

Course Descriptions

BUS 105 SOCIAL MEDIA MARKETING

3.0 Units 3.00 hours Lecture, Transfers: CSU

Social media implications, opportunities, and challenges for business and communications professions. Students will participate in content creation. They will learn practical, ethical, and effective use of an array of social media sites, applications, and resources. They will evaluate the impact, effectiveness, and design of various elements of social media marketing.

BUS 196 WORKPLACE SUCCESS SKILLS

1.0 Unit 1.00 hour Lecture, Transfers: CSU

Teaches the employability skills needed to succeed in a professional career field or work organization. The focus of this class is to teach students transferable skills necessary to succeed in the ever-changing workplace through teamwork, problem-solving, communication, self-management and responsibility, and career readiness. Students will enhance soft skills, workplace skills, interpersonal skills, communication skills, and leadership skills.

BUS 1 INTRODUCTION TO BUSINESS

3.0 Units 3.00 hours Lecture, Transfers: CSU, UC

Business concepts and practices; develops knowledge, thinking skills, and related business skills with regard to forms of ownership, management, finance, marketing, production, competition, technologies, global business, entrepreneurship, legal considerations, controls through which business organizations operate and other aspects of business.

CIMP 8A PROGRAMMING WITH PYTHON

3.0 Units 2.00 hours Lecture 3.00 hours Lab, Transfers: CSU, UC

Introductory programming course teaching standard algorithmic programming concepts using the Python programming language. Class covers syntax, variables, strings, conditions, flow control structures loops, switches, classes, database connections, utilities, short-circuit evaluations and frameworks. Class also covers data structures using sets, frozen sets, lists, arrays and dictionaries. No prior coding experience necessary. Class includes many python programming assignments and one large programming project. 25 hours of online instruction in addition to in-person class meetings.

ENV 1 INTRODUCTION TO ENVIRONMENTAL STUDIES

3.0 Units 3.00 hours Lecture, Transfers: CSU, UC

Introduction to environmental studies that includes an overview of human activities within the global ecosystem. Examines population growth, energy use, agricultural techniques, water quantity and quality, biodiversity, air quality, and waste disposal, and searches for solutions while exploring future options.

SOC 1 INTRODUCTION TO SOCIOLOGY

3.0 Units 3.00 hours Lecture, Transfers: CSU, UC

Introduction to the scientific study of society and human behavior, including core concepts and theories. Topics explored through the sociological perspective include: social institutions, culture, human behavior and relationships, social forces, socialization, social structure, social class, social inequality, gender, and social change. Credit may be earned for SOC 1 or 1H, but not both.

MUS 28 HISTORY OF ROCK

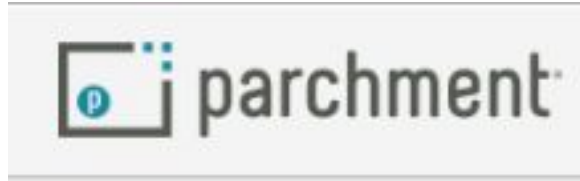
3.0 Units 3.00 hours Lecture, Transfers: CSU, UC

A study of the elements of rock music tracing the development and evolution of its styles and structures, including sociological and political aspects, from rock's beginning to the present time.

Unofficial Transcripts

- Student will need a copy of your unofficial transcript to complete your application to CSU and UC and private universities
- Available in your Student Portal ([LINK HERE](#))

Official Transcripts

- Private/Out of State Universities will require an official transcript as part of the application process.
- **Must be ordered online through [PARCHMENT](#).**

Matriculation

- Once you commit to a university (CSU, UC, private, out of state) you will be asked to send your final official transcript which includes your graduation date **PLEASE order your transcript online through PARCHMENT before June 6, 2025**



Letter of Recommendation

Do You Need a LETTER Written by a Counselor?

- Some private or out of state public schools require at least one *letter of recommendation written by a counselor*
- Your counselor will complete the Secondary School Report or Counselor's Report if the college requires one and the student requests them.

Due Date	Student Profile for Recommendation Due
Friday, September 13, 2024	College Applications with a November or December deadline
Friday, October 11, 2024	College Applications with a January or later deadline



Letter of Recommendation

- www.sjhhs.org
- Go to the Guidance tab and select College Information
 - Select Letter of Recommendation
- Academic/Teacher Letters
 - Ask a teacher in person that you feel knows you the best and can speak to who you are as a student.
 - Contact the teacher as early as possible.
 - Do not wait until the last minute
 - Be sure to THANK them. Teachers write the letters on their own time.

- Check the financial aid page on the website of the college/university you are applying to.
- Adhere to deadlines as they will be different and sometimes earlier than the admissions deadline!!

California Dream Act

- Can apply December 1, 2024
- Must meet AB 540 requirements



Scholarships

- Current list on the website and send information via Canvas announcements- [LINK](#)
- Students are responsible for researching and applying to scholarships on their own. - **Start Early!!!!!!**
- Follow deadlines and instructions for completing scholarship applications.
- Apply to as many as possible.



Are Senior Classes Important?

YES!!!

- UC and CSU do care about performance senior year - acceptance could be rescinded if grades go down.
- Private Schools ask counselors for reports as the year goes on. Any changes could change their admission decisions.
- Change status in NHS and CSF
- End of the year awards (Up to the Spring 12 week grade reporting period)
 - Scholar of Scholars
 - Valedictorian (GPA 4.0 +)
 - Academic Distinction (GPA 3.5 - 3.99)
