Honors Classes

- Honors classes are more rigorous classes that students looking for a more challenging curriculum may want to consider.
- It's important to remember that UC, CSU, and many private universities will only accept eight semesters of "Honors" and AP classes when considering a student for acceptance.
- Honors classes are based on a five-point grading scale.
 - A = 5
 - B = 4
 - C = 3
 - D = 1



Advanced Placement Classes

- AP classes are college level courses approved by the College Board.
- Passing optional end of course exam can earn students college credit.
- AP classes are based on a five-point grading scale.
 - A = 5
 - B = 4
 - C = 3
 - D = 1
